HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES OF WESTCHESTER

HDSW is a community-based nonprofit organization providing quality psychiatric, rehabilitative, health, residential, and community stabilization services in Westchester County. HDSW serves its clients and the community through a unique combination of inter-related programs. HDSW offers employment, educational, recreational and social engagement opportunities at **HOPE House**, its clubhouse in Port Chester. HDSW is also a provider of Health and Recovery Plans (**HARP**) offering to eligible consumers Home and Community Based Services (**HCBS**), which include the opportunity for increased employment, education, wellness and recovery services. HDSW's **Care Management** programs serve hundreds of Westchester residents, including those with behavioral health as well as persons with chronic medical conditions. HDSW is now a proud partner in the Community Oriented Re-Entry (**C.O.R.E.**) program operating at the Westchester County Jail, offering pre- and post- release services. **The HDSW Living Room, the newest Recovery Service, just opened in an office suite at the HDSW main office building in Mamaroneck. This day-time crisis respite hospital diversion service serves individuals throughout Westchester County with mental illness, who are in acute emotional distress.**

HDSW is also the designated **Neighborhood Preservation Company (NPC)** for the village of Port Chester, with the goal of increasing and preserving affordable housing for village residents, and is a HUD-approved Local Housing Counseling Agency, serving low and moderate-income residents throughout Westchester County. The NPC offers foreclosure mitigation and eviction prevention services, tenant assistance, home ownership counseling, financial literacy and other workshops.
